PUBLIC WORKS EXECUTION.

No. 10 of 1957.

AN ACT to provide for the execution and carrying out of certain public works and purposes, and to authorize the borrowing of certain sums of money for meeting the cost of those works and purposes, and to amend the Public Works Execution Act (No. 3) 1956. [3 April 1957.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

PART I.

PRELIMINARY

Short title.

Interpretation.

1 This Act may be cited as the Public Works Execution Act 1957.

2 In this Act, "Financial Agreement" means the agreement made between the Commonwealth and the States and ratified by the Financial Agreement Act 1927, and includes that agreement as varied from time to time and any agreement made in substitution therefor.

PART II.

PUBLIC WORKS AND PURPOSES GENERALLY.

Works and to be executed and

3-(1) The public works and purposes specified in the schedule may be executed and carried out by the Minister administering the Act or Department under or for the purposes of which those works and purposes are respectively reguired to be executed and carried out.

(2) The cost of a public work or purpose specified in the schedule shall not exceed the amount set forth therein in respect of each work or purpose.

4 The Treasurer may arrange for the borrowing, in accordance with the Financial Agreement, of any sums of money not exceeding £143,460, and may apply the sums so borrowed for the purpose of meeting the cost of the execution and carrying out of the public works and purposes specified in the schedule.

Power of Treasurer to borrow £143,460.

5-(1) The Public Works Execution Act (No. 3) 1956 is Amendment amended-

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (b) of section four (No. 3) 1956. the numerals "£81,700 10s. 2d" and contained on the section four (No. 3) 1956. the numerals "£81,700 10s. 2d." and substitut-ing therefor the numerals "£81,170 10s. 2d.";
- (b) by omitting from section five the numerals "£43,200" and substituting therefor the numerals " £48,200 ";
 - (c) by omitting item 48 from the second schedule and substituting therefor the following item:-
 - "48 West Coast aerodromes construction 25,000.";
 - (d) by omitting the total to that schedule and substituting therefor the total "£48,200";
 - (e) by omitting from the summary to the schedules to the Act the numerals "43,200" and substituting therefor the numerals "48,200"; and
 - (f) by omitting from that summary the numerals "9,702,360" and substituting therefor the numerals "9,707,360".

(2) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on the date of the commencement of the Public Works Execution Act (No. 3) 1956.
