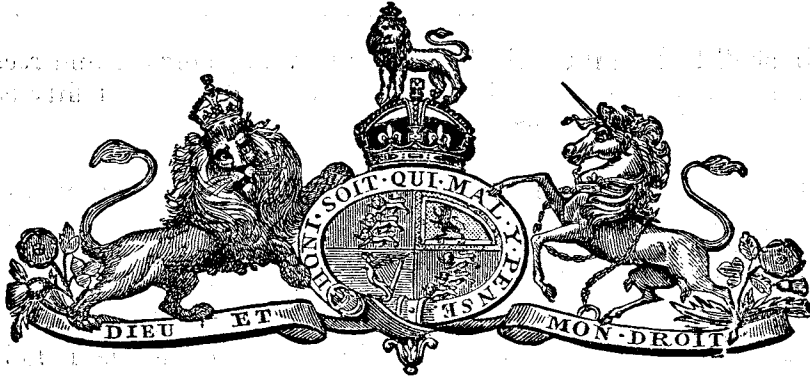

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Public Works. [20 December, 1935.]

A.D. 1935.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1 This Act may be cited as the *Public Works Execution Act* Short title. (No. 2) 1935.
- 2 Subject to the provisions of the *Public Works Committee Act* 1914, as modified by this Act, the Minister may cause the works mentioned in the schedule to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceeding the amount set forth in the said schedule. Power to Minister to cause works to be executed. 5 Geo. V. No. 32.

3 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to raise, borrow, and receive any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole the sum of fifty-eight thousand pounds for the purposes of this Act.

4 The provisions of the *Public Works Construction Act* 1880 shall apply to the works mentioned in the schedule in the same manner as if those provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

5 In the application of the provisions of the *Public Works Committee Act* 1914 to the works mentioned in the schedule, the following provisions shall have effect :—

i. It shall not be necessary for the Governor to refer such works to the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Works until after the commencement of this Act :

ii. It shall not be necessary for the House of Assembly to declare that it is expedient to carry out such works, and such works may be commenced if the said Committee reports to the Governor that in its opinion such works should be undertaken—

but such works shall not be commenced or executed unless the Committee so reports in respect thereof.

6 The first schedule to the *Public Works Execution Act (No. 2)* 1934 is hereby amended by deleting the words "New Hospitals, Hobart and Launceston" and substituting therefor the words "New Hospital, Hobart".
