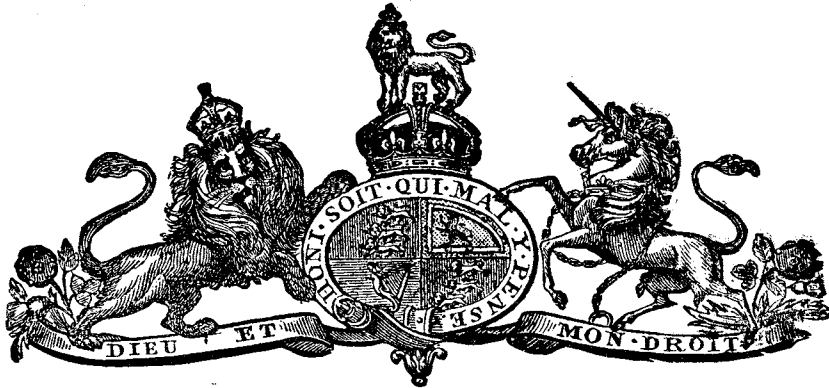

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of  
certain Public Works. [20 December, 1935.]

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Public Works Execution Act* Short title.  
(No. 3) 1935.

2 The Minister may cause the works specified in the schedule to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceeding in each case the amount set forth in such schedule in respect of each work, together with the cost of supervision thereof not exceeding the amount provided therefor in the schedule. Power to Minister to cause works to be executed.

**3** It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to raise, borrow, and receive any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of eighteen thousand two hundred and eighty pounds for defraying the cost of the works authorised by this Act.

**4** The provisions of the *Public Works Construction Act 1880* shall apply to any public works constructed under this Act in the same manner as if those provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

**5** The Marine Board of Launceston (hereinafter called "the Board") shall at all times, at its own expense and cost, maintain and keep in good order and repair, and renew as and when necessary—

- i. The interstate jetty at Inspection Head, River Tamar, to be constructed under this Act : and
- ii. The existing jetty at Beauty Point, River Tamar, aforesaid.

**6—(1)** If the Board shall make default in doing or carrying out, to the satisfaction of the Minister, any of the maintenance or other works required by section five to be done or carried out by the Board, the Minister may serve by post on the Board a notice, signed by him, requiring the Board to do or carry out, within a time to be specified therein, the work in respect of which the Board has so made default.

**(2)** If the Board shall fail to comply with such notice within the time so specified, the Minister may do or carry out the work in respect of which the Board has made default, and the cost incurred by the Minister in so doing shall be a debt due and payable by the Board to His Majesty, and be recoverable accordingly.
