- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Circular Head Marine Board Loan Act 1952.
- (2) The Circular Head Marine Board Loan Act 1950, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Power to borrow for 2 Section three of the Principal Act is amended by certain works. omitting therefrom the numerals "£32,000" and substituting Power to borrow for therefor the numerals "£60,000".

# COMMONWEALTH POWERS (AIR TRANS-PORT).
