AN ACT to amend the *Roads and Jetties Act* 1935. A.D. 1945.
[7 December, 1945.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Roads and Jetties Act* 1945. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Roads and Jetties Act* 1935*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

A.D. 1945. **2** Subsection (1) of section three of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "highway" in the definition of "Road authority" the words "or subsidiary road".

3 Section forty-two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "or hedge", wherever occurring, and substituting therefor the words "hedge, tree, or vegetation".
