ROADS AND JETTIES.

AN ACT to amend the Roads and Jetties Act 1935.

[7 December 1972.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Roads and Jetties Act 1972. Short title and citation.
- (2) The Roads and Jetties Act 1935, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- **2** Section five of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in Application subsection (1) after paragraph (d) the following paragraph:—

 Application of Fund.
 - "(da) all costs and expenses (including the costs of supervision) incurred by the Minister while the Commonwealth Aid Roads Act 1969 is in force in or in connection with the maintenance of country roads within the Hobart Statistical Division and Urban Launceston, being the urban areas as defined and referred to in section two of that Act;".
