## AN ACT to amend the Roads and Jetties Act 1935

# [Royal Assent 21 December 1989]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

### Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Roads and Jetties Amendment Act (No. 2) 1989.

### Commencement

2—This Act is deemed to have commenced on 1st July 1989.

# Section 4 amended (State Highway Trust Fund)

- 3—Section 4 of the Roads and Jetties Act 1935\* is amended as follows:—
  - (a) by omitting paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (h) of subsection (2);
  - (b) by omitting subsection (2A);
  - (c) by omitting subparagraph (ii) of subsection (3) (a) and substituting—
    - (ii) revenue derived from the use and operation of any jetty the control and management of which are vested in the Minister under Part V; and
  - (d) by omitting paragraph (b) of subsection (3) and substituting—
    - (b) the money received by it in each financial year from sums, fees and charges imposed under section 20A of the *Traffic Act 1925*.
  - (e) by omitting subsections (4), (5) and (6).

# Scheduled projects

- 4—A project for the construction or maintenance of a State highway or a subsidiary road that would not have been considered and reported on by the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Works in accordance with section 15 of the Public Works Committee Act 1914 if this Act had not been passed shall not be required to be considered and reported on by that Committee in accordance with that section unless—
  - (a) the project is planned to start after 30th June 1991; or
  - (b) work on the project to a value in excess of \$1 000 000 is planned to take place after that date.
