AN ACT to amend the Retirement Benefits Act 1970.

[20 December 1978]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Retirement Benefits Act 1978*. Short title.

2—In this Act, the *Retirement Benefits Act 1970** is referred to as the Principal Act. Principal Act.

3—Section 26 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (4) the numeral “1979” and substituting the numeral “1980”.

4—Section 27 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (5A) (a) the numeral “1979” and substituting the numeral “1980”.
