AN ACT to amend the Retirement Benefits Act 1970. [20 December 1978]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1-This Act may be cited as the Retirement Benefits Act 1978. Short title.

2—In this Act, the Retirement Benefits Act 1970* is referred to Principal Act. as the Principal Act.

3—Section 26 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (4) the numeral "1979" and substituting the numeral "1980".
