AN ACT to amend the Rates Exemption Act 1934. [22 July, 1942.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:--

- 1 This Act may be cited as the Rates Exemption Act 1942. Short title.
- 2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after Amendment the word "college" last occurring in the amendment in section No. 75, s. 4. four thereof, enacted by the Proclamations Confirmation Act 1938 (being the last word in the antepenultimate line of the section as reprinted in the Reprint) the words "and to any land exclusively used for the purposes of a hostel for school children or students which is not carried on for purposes of profit.".
