AN ACT to amend the *Rural Industries Act 1943*.
[18 December, 1951.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Rural Industries Act 1951*.

(2) The *Rural Industries Act 1943**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section nine of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsections (1) and (3), respectively, the word “two” and substituting therefor, in each case, the word “three.”

TASMANIAN ORCHESTRA (CONTINUATION).

AN ACT to provide for continuing the Orchestra known as the Tasmanian Orchestra.
[18 December, 1951.]

PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS provision was made in the *Tasmanian Orchestra (Agreement) Act 1948** for the establishment of an orchestra to be known as the Tasmanian Orchestra, and for its maintenance for a period of three years from the first day of March nineteen hundred and forty-eight, and for the Minister therein named to execute and carry out an agreement in accordance with certain heads of agreement in a schedule thereto set out, and for the councils of the Cities of Hobart and Launceston to have a part in the matter as therein set out:
