AN ACT to amend the Real Property (Special Vesting Orders) Act 1973.

[30 November 1978]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Real Property (Special Vesting Orders) Act 1978*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Real Property (Special Vesting Orders) Act 1973** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsections:—

“(2) Subject to subsection (3), the Governor may, from time to time, by order, extend the period within which an application may be made to the Recorder under subsection (1).

“(3) An order under subsection (2) shall not extend the period referred to in that subsection later than 1st August 1983, or until the *Land Titles Act* 1978 is proclaimed, whichever is the sooner.”.

Extension of
period for
applications.

3—(1) Notwithstanding any order-in-council made under section 3 (2) of the Principal Act before the commencement of this Act, the period within which an application may be made under subsection (1) of that section is, by force of this section, extended to 1st August 1979.

(2) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st August 1978.
