AN ACT to amend the Road Safety (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1970.

[21 June 1976]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:---

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Road Safety (Alcohol and Short tile Drugs) Act 1976.

(2) The Road Safety (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1970, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. Restriction on grant of drivers' licences for certain persons previously disqualified under this Act.

2 Section 19B of the Principal Act is repealed.
