

**SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION, 1948-49**

No. 25 of 1949.

AN ACT supplementary to the Acts for appropriating certain Sums arising from the Consolidated Revenue to the Service of the State of Tasmania for the Year ended the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine.

[30 September, 1949.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation Act 1948-49.* Short title.

**2** The sum of two hundred and fourteen thousand four hundred and forty-two pounds eighteen shillings, which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue of the State of Tasmania for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, for the several purposes specified in the schedule shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the *Appropriation Act 1948-49* for the purposes and services expressed in the schedule.

### No. 26 of 1949.

AN ACT to apply out of the Consolidated Revenue a sum for the Service of the year ending the Thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty.  
[30 September, 1949.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Supply Act (No. 2), 1949-50.*

Issue and application of £594,000.

**2** There shall and may be issued and applied towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty, the sum of five hundred
