

2—(1) The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue (which, to the necessary extent, is hereby appropriated accordingly) a sum not exceeding £25,000 and apply that sum for the purpose expressed in the schedule. Appropriation and application of £25,000.

(2) The sum appropriated by subsection (1) of this section may be applied in the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1952, and in any subsequent financial years, and may be applied partly in any one financial year and partly in any other financial year or financial years.

STATE ADVANCES (No. 2).

No. 27 of 1952.

AN ACT to amend the *State Advances Act 1935*. [30 September, 1952.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *State Advances Act* (No. 2) 1952. Short title and citation.

(2) The *State Advances Act 1935*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section fourteen A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) all the words after the word "section" to the end of that subsection. Power to borrow.
