

## STANLEY COOL STORES.

AN ACT to amend the *Stanley Cool Stores Act*  
1945. [29 November, 1949.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Stanley Cool Stores Act* 1949. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Stanley Cool Stores Act* 1945\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section three of the Principal Act is amended— Constitution of the Board.

(a) by omitting from subsection (1) the words “as provided in this section” and substituting therefor the words “by the Governor, one of whom shall be appointed by him as chairman”; and

(b) by omitting subsection (2).

**3** Section twelve of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of subsection (2), after the words “cool stores”, the words “together with interest at four and a half per cent per annum to the company on the balance of the amount provided by it then remaining unpaid.” Application of profits.
