

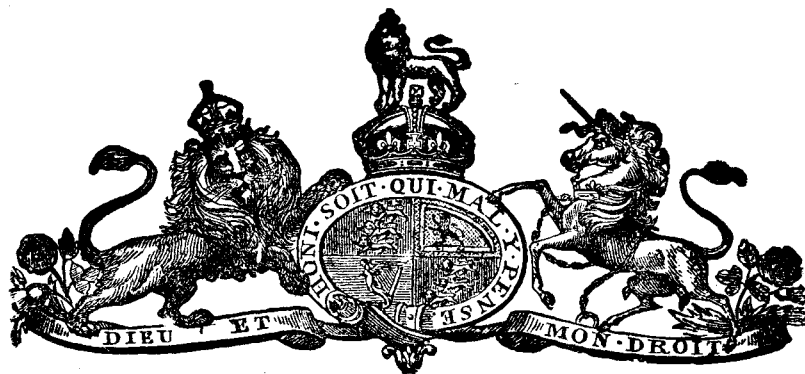

AN ACT to revise the Statute Law of this State ; to repeal certain Enactments which have become unnecessary ; to amend certain Acts ; to eliminate certain Definitions, Provisions, and Words rendered unnecessary by the *Acts Interpretation Act* 1931 and other Acts ; to assign Short Titles to Acts where necessary and to simplify the Short Titles of certain Acts ; and to secure, as far as practicable, a greater Measure of Uniformity of Form and Expression in Legislative Enactments. BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Statute Law Revision Act* Short title. 1934

Statute Law Revision.

Repeal.

2—(1) The enactments enumerated in the first schedule are hereby repealed to the extent therein indicated.

(2) Where in the first schedule an Imperial Act is expressed to be repealed it shall be intended that the same shall no longer extend or apply to this State.

Saving of effect of certain amending enactments repealed.

3 The repeal by this Act of any enactment the only effect of which was to amend a prior enactment by—

I. Repealing, expunging, or deleting any Part, Division, section, subsection, schedule, word, or numeral from: or

II. Inserting or substituting any such matter as aforesaid in—

the text of such prior enactment, shall not affect the operation of the amendment so made, but such prior enactment shall continue to be read and construed as altered by such repealed enactment as if the same had not been repealed, subject, however, to the provisions of any subsequent Act amending or modifying the same.

Special provisions relating to reprinting of Statutes.

4 In the reprinting of the Statute Law of this State or of any part thereof, effect shall be given to the following provisions:—

I. Every Act shall have a short title, which shall consist of the necessary descriptive words followed by the word "Act" and the year of enactment (in figures), and which shall be printed without parentheses except where the same are required in setting out the descriptive words aforesaid:

II. Where sections or subsections of an Act are indented and divided into paragraphs, the paragraphs shall be numbered with small capital Roman numerals; divisions of paragraphs by small alphabetical letters; and subdivisions by small letters:

III. Where there are more schedules than one to an Act, such schedules shall be called and cited as "the first schedule," "the second schedule," and so on according to their number: and

IV. Where a section inserted by amendment is distinguished from a section of similar number by a letter of the alphabet, such letter shall be a capital, and the citation of such section shall be by the number of the section in words followed by such letter—

and it shall be lawful for the Government Printer, by direction of the Attorney-General, to make such alterations in the text of any Act as may be necessary to give effect to these provisions.

5—(1) Every public general Act to which this section is applicable is hereby amended—

- I. By deleting from the title thereof the words—
 - (a) “Further” before the word “amend”:
 - (b) “and for other purposes”:

General amendment of certain formal parts of Acts and deletion of words which have become unnecessary.

- II. By deleting from the short title thereof the word or words “Amendment” or “Act amendment” immediately preceding the word “Act” lastly occurring therein—

if such words respectively are so used therein.

(2) Where in any such Act as aforesaid the words and figures “*Bankruptcy Act 1870*” are used there shall be substituted therefor the words “law relating to bankruptcy.”

(3) In every such Act as aforesaid there shall be deleted the words—

- I. “Hobart Town,” “Hobart,” “Government,” or “Tasmanian Government” wherever occurring immediately before the word “Gazette” except where the same is defined in the *Acts Interpretation Act 1931*:
- II. “from time to time” wherever used for the purpose of indicating when a power may be exercised or a duty shall be performed:
- III. “the” where used before “appendix” if there are more appendices than one to a schedule:
- IV. “hereto,” “to this Act,” “annexed hereto,” “annexed to this Act” respectively used (in any order) after the words “schedule” or “appendix” (whether or not such word is followed by a numeral or words indicating a number) to indicate that a schedule (or an appendix thereto) to the Act in which the same are used is intended:
- V. “of this Act” after the words “Part” or “section” (whether or not such word is followed by a numeral or number):
- VI. “or to the like effect” where used in relation to a prescribed form elsewhere than in the *Acts Interpretation Act 1931*:
- VII. “Colonial” where used before “Treasurer,” “Treasury,” or “Secretary” (except in the *Ministers of the Crown (Designation) Act 1883*), and, where (except as aforesaid) the same is used before “Secretary,” the word “Chief” shall be substituted therefor:
- VIII. “Town,” wherever occurring, immediately following “Hobart”:

- IX. "in Council," wherever occurring, immediately following "Governor," except where the expression "Governor in Council" is used in juxtaposition with the word "Governor" used alone:
- X. "of the Peace," wherever occurring, immediately after "Justice" or "Justices," excepting in the *Acts Interpretation Act 1931* and the *District Justices Act 1907*.

(4) Where by this Act the preamble to an Act is expunged, the word "therefore" used in the enacting clause thereof shall be deleted.

Amendment
of Acts in
second
schedule.

6—(1) The Acts enumerated in the second schedule are hereby amended in the manner and to the extent indicated in the fourth column of that schedule.

(2) Where, in the fourth column of the second schedule, any word or numeral is cited, the citation thereof shall have reference, unless the contrary intention appears, to such word or numeral where first occurring in the Part or section in relation to which it is cited; or, if other words or numerals of the same Part or section are previously cited, where first occurring after the last of such words or numerals so cited.

Short titles.

7 Where in any Act an Act is cited, the short title of which has been inserted or amended by this Act, the citation thereof shall be so amended that the short title shall correspond with the short title as inserted or amended by this Act, and this provision shall extend to the citations of Acts in the schedules to this Act.
