No. 23 of 1965.

AN ACT to amend the Sunday Observance Act 1908 and the Sunday Observance Act 1962.

[12 October 1965.]

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Sunday Observance Short title and citation. $Ac\overline{t}$ 1965.
- (2) The Sunday Observance Act 1908, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2—(1) Section four of the Sunday Observance Act 1962 Adaptation of (a) by inserting in subsection (1), after the symbol Principal Act.

 "'XA'", the symbols ",'(a)', '(b)'"; and

 (b) by omitting from that subsection is amended—

 - word "'(k)', and '(m)'"; and substituting therefor the symbols and word "'(ja)', '(i)', '(ii)', and '(l)''.
- (2) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on the date of the commencement of the Sunday Observance Act 1962.
 - 3 Section eleven of the Principal Act is amended—

Works of necessity or

- (a) by omitting paragraph (ja) and substituting mercy not prohibited. therefor the following paragraph:—
 - "(ja) The delivery for sale of—
 - (i) a newspaper or edition of a newspaper that is printed for the purpose of publication on Sundays: or
 - (ii) a newspaper or edition of a newspaper published on a Saturday that is specified in an order for the time being in force under subsection (4) of section fifty-seven of the Factories, Shops, and Offices Act 1965;"; and

- (b) by omitting paragraphs (m) and (n) of that subsection.
- 4 After section fourteen of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

Exemption of certain shops.

"15 Nothing in this Act affects shops as defined in the Factories, Shops, and Offices Act 1965.".

5 The second schedule to the Principal Act is repealed.

RACING AND GAMING (No. 2).

AN ACT to amend the *Racing and Gaming Act* 1952. [12 October 1965.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title, citation, and commence-

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Racing and Gaming Act (No. 2) 1965.
- (2) The Racing and Gaming Act 1952, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall commence on the fourteenth day of February 1966.

Stamp duty on betting 2 Section seventy-two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) thereof the word "twopence" and substituting therefor the words "two cents".
