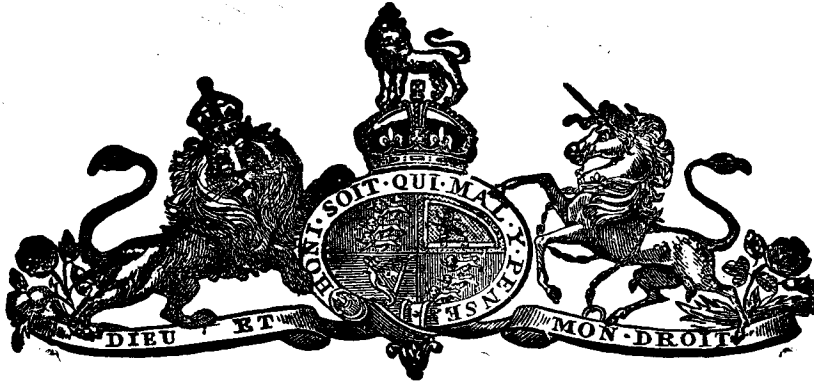

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Works in connection with the Provision by the State of Accommodation Houses for Tourists. [2 November, 1934.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *State Tourist Accommodation Houses Execution Act 1934*. Short title.

2 The Minister may cause the works specified in the schedule to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceeding in each case the amount specified therein in respect of each work. Power to Minister to cause works to be executed.

3 The Treasurer may raise, borrow, and receive any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of one thousand pounds for the purpose of defraying the costs of the execution of the works authorised by this Act.
