AN ACT to amend the *Transport Act 1938*.
 [17 November, 1944.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Transport Act 1944*. Short title and citation.
 (2) The *Transport Act 1938**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section nineteen of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting paragraph VII. of subsection (1) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“VII. All moneys received by the State from the Commonwealth under the agreement approved by the *Federal Aid Roads and Works Agreement Act 1937**.”;

(b) by omitting paragraph I. of subsection (2) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“I. All moneys received by this State from the Commonwealth under the agreement approved by the *Federal Aid Roads and Works Agreement Act 1937**.”; and

(c) by omitting paragraph I. of subsection (3) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“I. Paragraph VII. of subsection (1), in accordance with the agreement approved by the *Federal Aid Roads and Works Agreement Act 1937**: and”.
