BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
 by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
 Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
 as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Towns Act* 1944.

(2) The *Towns Act* 1934*, as subsequently amended, is in
 this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

A.D. 1944. **2** Paragraph x. of subsection (1) of section thirty-six of the Principal Act is amended by deleting the words "a substantial five-feet paling fence, or, where the council approves, a post and four-rail fence," and substituting therefor the words "a fence of such size and kind as the council may direct,".
