AN ACT to amend the Towns Act 1934. [17 November, 1944.]

A.D. 1**944.**

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Towns Act 1944.

(2) The Towns Act 1934*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Paragraph x. of subsection (1) of section thirty-six of the Principal Act is amended by deleting the words "a substantial five-feet paling fence, or, where the council approves, a post and four-rail fence," and substituting therefor the words "a fence of such size and kind as the council may direct,".
