Medical

FILLED MILK.

No. 6 of 1960.

AN ACT to prohibit the manufacture and sale of filled milk, and to provide for matters incidental [20 June 1960.] thereto.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Filled Milk Act 1960. Short title

"butter fat" means the fat of cow's milk:
