

TRAFFIC (No. 2).

No. 73 of 1963.

AN ACT to amend the *Traffic Act 1925*.

[3 December 1963.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Traffic Act (No. 2)* Short title and citation.
1963.

(2) The *Traffic Act 1925*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section ten of the Principal Act is amended—Regulations as to vehicle registration, &c.

- (a) by omitting from the paragraph inserted in subsection (1) thereof by paragraph (a) of section three of the *Traffic Act (No. 2)* 1958 the word “tractor” (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word “vehicle”;
- (b) by omitting from subsection (3) the word “tractor” (first occurring) and substituting therefor the words “vehicle to which this subsection applies”;
- (c) by omitting from that subsection the word “tractor” (second occurring) and substituting therefor the word “vehicle”;
- (d) by omitting from subsection (4) the word “tractor” (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word “vehicle”; and
- (e) by inserting after that subsection the following subsection:—

“(4A) Subsection (3) of this section applies to tractors and to self-propelled agricultural or horticultural implements or machinery.”.

3 Section sixty-six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (1) the word “tractor” (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word “vehicle”. No registration without insurance.
