## TRAFFIC (No. 2).

## No. 73 of 1963.

## AN ACT to amend the *Traffic Act* 1925. [3 December 1963.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Traffic Act (No. 2) Short title and citation.
- (2) The Traffic Act 1925, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
  - 2 Section ten of the Principal Act is amended—

Regulations as to vehicle registration,

- (a) by omitting from the paragraph inserted in subsection (1) thereof by paragraph (a) of section three of the *Traffic Act* (No. 2) 1958 the word "tractor" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "vehicle";
- (b) by omitting from subsection (3) the word "tractor" (first occurring) and substituting therefor the words "vehicle to which this subsection applies";
- (c) by omitting from that subsection the word "tractor" (second occurring) and substituting therefor the word "vehicle";
- (d) by omitting from subsection (4) the word "tractor" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "vehicle"; and
- (e) by inserting after that subsection the following subsection:—
  - "(4A) Subsection (3) of this section applies to tractors and to self-propelled agricultural or horticultural implements or machinery.".

**3** Section sixty-six of the Principal Act is amended by omit-No registrating from paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (1) the word insurance. "tractor" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "vehicle".
