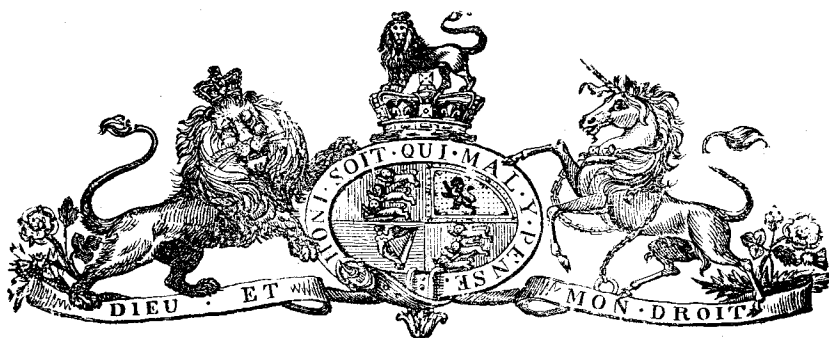

AN ACT to further amend "The Assessment Act, 1898." [7 May, 1900.] A.D. 1900.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Assessment Amendment Act, 1900." Short title.

2 In this Act, the words "the said Act" shall mean "The Assessment Act, 1898." Interpretation. 62 Vict. No. 33.

3 Notwithstanding anything contained in the said Act it shall not be necessary for the Local Authority of any District to cause an Assessment Roll of the property in such District to be prepared during the year One thousand nine hundred. Preparation of Rolls in 1900 unnecessary.

4 Any Assessment Roll now in force, or hereafter to be prepared or completed under the provisions of the said Act, shall, subject to such insertions, additions, alterations, or amendments as are mentioned in the said Act, be deemed to be and shall be the Assessment Roll, and shall remain and continue in force until the Thirty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred ; and all Taxes and Rates may be lawfully made and levied upon the capital value or annual value of the property within the District, as shown by such Roll. Existing Rolls extended.

5 This Act and the said Act and every Act amending the same, save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act. Acts to be read together.
