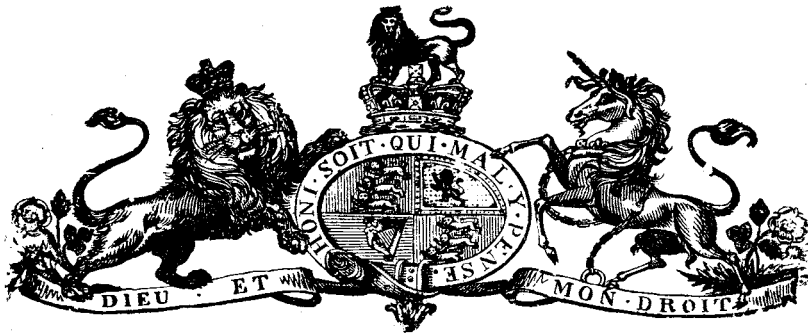

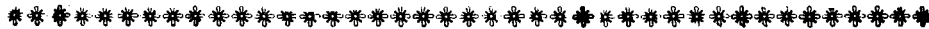

AN ACT to amend "The Agent-General's Act, 1885." [25 September, 1903.] A.D. 1903.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Agent-General's Amendment Act, 1903." Short Title.

2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" means "The Agent-General's Act, 1885." Interpretation. 49 Vict. No. 19.

3 Section Five of the said Act and the Schedule thereto are hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof the following Section and Schedule shall be deemed to be and may be cited as Section Five of the said Act and the Schedule thereto respectively, that is to say :— Sect. 5 of 49 Vict. No. 19 and Schedule repealed and re-enacted.

"5 Upon the appointment of an Agent-General under this Act there shall and may be yearly appropriated, issued, and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the State of *Tasmania* a sum not Salary of Agent-General and Staff.

Amendment of
Section Six of
49 Vict. No. 19.

4 The words "Two thousand six hundred" in the First and Second lines of Section Six of the said Act are hereby repealed, and the words "One thousand three hundred and ten" are inserted in lieu thereof, and the said Section shall hereafter be construed as if the words "One thousand three hundred and ten" had been originally inserted.

5 This Act shall come into operation on the Thirty-first day of *December, 1903.*
