

ACT to further amend "The Audit A.D. 1903. [23] December, 1903.] Act, 1901."

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Audit Amendment Act, 1903." Short title.

2 This Act shall commence and come into operation on the First Operation of Act. day of January, one thousand nine hundred and four.

3 In the construction of this Act the expression "the said Act" Interpretation. shall mean "The Audit Act, 1901." 1 Edward VII. No. 15.

4 From and after the commencement of this Act, the financial year Financial year referred to in this Act and the said Act shall be and be taken to be from to be from 1st July to the First day of July to the Thirtieth day of June next following. 30th June.

5 In Section Twenty-six of the said Act, in place of the words "the Amendment in Thirty-first day of December" in the first and second lines, the words Section 26 of "the Thirtieth day of June" are hereby substituted,

Amendments in "General Regulations" and "Instructions."

6 The General Regulations set forth in the Schedule (2.) to the said Act, and the Instructions set forth in the Schedule (3.) to the same Act shall be and the same are hereby amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule; and all copies of such General Regulations and of such Instructions printed thereafter shall be printed according as the amendments made by this Act require.

Acts to be read together.

7 This Act and the said Act, and every Act altering or amending the same, save as altered or amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.

SCHEDULE.

GENERAL REGULATIONS.

Regulation numbered 1 to read as follows:-

1. The year of Account is in all cases from 1st July to 30th June.

In Regulation numbered 30, paragraph (1), in place of "31st December," "30th June" to be substituted; in place of "10th January," "10th July" to be substituted; and in place of "December" "June" to be substituted.

INSTRUCTIONS.

Paragraph numbered 4 to read as follows:-

4. The year of Account is to be from 1st July to the 30th June.

In paragraph numbered 15, in place of "April," "October" to be substituted.

In paragraph numbered 22, in place of "31st December," "30th June" to be substituted.

Paragraph numbered 23 to read as follows:-

23. In order to provide for expenditure authorised before the 30th June, a sum equal to such authorised expenditure is to be made available as a credit for such financial year, until the 31st day of August in the succeeding financial year. All such credits not then expended are to lapse.
