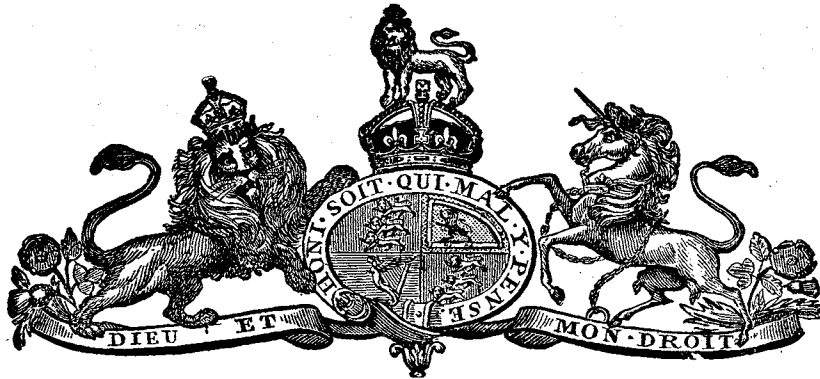

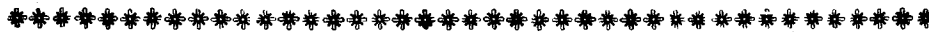

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The Auction Amendment Act, 1919," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The Auction Act, 1913." Short title and incorporation with 4. Geo. V. No. 37.

2—(1) Subsection (3) of Section Seven of "The Auction Act, 1913," is hereby amended by omitting the proviso thereto and by adding at the end of the subsection the following words:—" Provided that where any licence is issued after the Thirtieth day of June in any year, the fee payable in respect thereof shall be ~~Twenty-five~~ **Twenty-five** Pounds for a general licence, and **Ten** Pounds for a limited licence."

(2) The amendment made by this section shall have a retrospective effect as from the First day of July, 1919.
