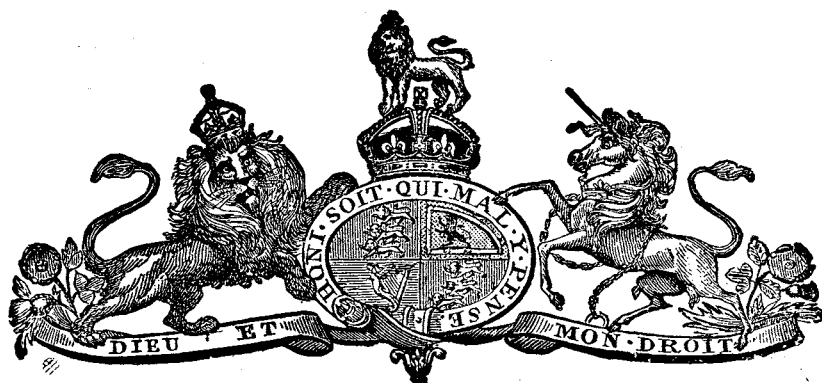

AN ACT to amend "The Apples and Pears Act, 1918." [14 February, 1922.]

A.D. 1921.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Apples and Pears Act, Short title, 1921."

(2) "The Apples and Pears Act, 1918," is herein called the Principal Act. 9 Geo. V. No. 21.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting therein after Section Fifteen the following new Section 15a :—

Addition of new Section 15a to Principal Act.

"15a Any inspector may enter any place where apples or pears for export are being handled, or are stacked or loaded, or being stacked or loaded, for transport, for the purpose of supervising or inspecting the handling, stacking, or loading thereof."

Inspectors may supervise, &c., stacking and loading.

Amendment of
Section 11 of
Principal Act.

3 Section Eleven of the Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after Paragraph iv. thereof the following new Paragraph iva.:—

“ iva. The methods to be observed in the handling, stacking, and loading of apples and pears for export, and the precautions to be taken by persons engaged therein, and generally for the protection of such apples and pears from damage :”
