AN ACT to further amend "The Amusements 1917. Duties Act, 1916," and for other purposes. [8 December, 1917.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1-(1) This Act may be cited as "The Amusements Duties Amend-Short title and ment Act (No. 2), 1917."

(2) This Act is incorporated with "The Amusements Duties Act, with 7 Geo. V. 1916" (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Act"), and any No. 31 and 7 Geo. V. No. 54. amendment thereof.

(3) The Principal Act, as amended by "The Amusements Duties Amendment Act, 1917," and by this Act, may be cited as "The Amusements Duties Acts, 1916–17."

2 After Section Fifteen of the Principal Act the following sections are inserted:—

"15a--(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, amusements duty shall not be charged on payments for admission to the amusements known as merry-go-rounds, but the promotor of every such amusement shall apply for and obtain a licence for and in respect of every merry-go-round in respect of which payment for admission is charged.

"(2) Every such licence shall be in force from the day following the date thereof until the Thirtieth day of June then next following.

"(3) The fee for every such licence—

1. Shall be Five Pounds in respect of a merry-go-round operated by hand power:

II. Shall be Ten Pounds in respect of a merry-go-round operated

by any other kind of power.

Issue of licences.

"15b Upon the application in writing of the promoter of any such amusement, and upon payment of the fee therefor, the Treasurer may issue to him a licence authorising him to admit persons to such amusement for payment.

Admission to unlicensed merry-go-round.

"15c If any person is admitted for payment to a merry-go-round in respect whereof the promotor has not obtained a licence under this Act, the promotor shall be guilty of an offence. Penalty: Fifty Pounds.

Governor may by proclamation apply foregoing provisions to other amusements.

"15d—(1) The Governor may by proclamation extend and apply the provisions of Sections 15a to 15d inclusive to any other specified amusement if he considers such amusement should be treated in the same way as a merry go-round, and he may fix the licence fee for the same at any sum not exceeding Ten Pounds.

"(2) Upon the publication of the proclamation the provisions of this Act with respect to the promotor of a merry-go-round shall apply to the

promoter of the amusement referred to in the proclamation.'
