

ANALYSIS.

2. Where right not capable of coming into existence.

AN ACT to declare the Law with respect to 1910. [25 August, 1910.] Ancient Lights.

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Ancient Lights Declaratory Act, Short title. 1910."
