BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation. **1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Tasmanian Auxiliary Nursing Service Act 1954.

(2) The Tasmanian Auxiliary Nursing Service Act 1949 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Qualifications for registration.

2 Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (c) of subsection (1) the words "sound health and".
