

TASMANIAN AUXILIARY NURSING SERVICE.

No. 59 of 1963.

AN ACT to amend the *Tasmanian Auxiliary Nursing Service Act 1949*. [1 November 1963.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Tasmanian Auxiliary Nursing Service Act 1963*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Tasmanian Auxiliary Nursing Service Act 1949*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section five of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end of sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) thereof the words “or as geriatric nurses”. Qualifications for registration.

NURSES' REGISTRATION.

AN ACT to amend the *Nurses' Registration Act 1952*. [1 November 1963.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Nurses' Registration Act 1963*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Nurses' Registration Act 1952*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word “or” at the end of paragraph (d) of subsection (1) thereof, and by inserting after paragraph (e) of that subsection the following word and paragraph:—

“(f) geriatric nurse.”
