AN ACT to regulate the Payment of certain Moneys in Aid of Road Rates, and for other purposes. A.D. 1907.
[5 December, 1907.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Aid to Road Rates Act, 1907.” Short title.

2 There shall be payable by the Treasurer of the State in the financial year ending the Thirtieth day of *June*, One thousand nine hundred and eight, out of the Consolidated Revenue, subject as hereinafter provided, any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole Subsidy in aid of road rates.

Seven thousand Pounds, for and towards the construction and repair of roads and streets, other than main roads, and of bridges; and such moneys shall be payable to the municipal councils to be constituted under "The Local Government Act, 1906," and shall be distributed amongst them upon and subject to the following conditions, namely:—

- i. The distribution shall be paid as directed by the Minister for Lands and Works upon the basis of the actual collections already made in respect of road rates of not less than One Shilling in the Pound levied on the annual value of property in respect of the year ended the Twenty-eighth day of *February*, One thousand nine hundred and seven:
- ii. The amount payable to the municipal council of a municipality shall be in proportion to the total sum which has been actually collected as the proceeds of any such road rate as aforesaid, levied in respect of the said year upon the annual value of any properties which are within that municipality:
- iii. In any case where any such road rate shall have been so made or levied of more than One Shilling in the Pound on the annual value of property the collections in excess of a One Shilling rate shall be disregarded, and the distribution shall be made on the basis of the collection of a One Shilling rate only; and the Auditor-General is hereby empowered to determine the amount of such collection:
- iv. If any doubt or difficulty arises in connection with the distribution the same shall be settled by the Minister for Lands and Works, and his decision shall be final.

3 Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall be payable, subject as hereinafter provided, by the Treasurer of the State in the financial year ending the Thirtieth day of *June*, One thousand nine hundred and eight, to any municipal council to be constituted under "The Local Government Act, 1906," upon and subject to the following conditions, a subsidy in respect of road rate collections, to be determined as follows, namely:—

- i. The amount payable shall be based upon the actual collections already made in respect only of properties within the municipality under any road rate exceeding One Shilling in the Pound levied on the annual value of properties in respect of the year ended the Twenty-eighth day of *February*, One thousand nine hundred and seven, and the amount to be paid the council of such municipality by way of subsidy shall be a sum equal to the amount of money so collected as aforesaid by virtue of such rate which is in excess of the amount of money which would have been so collected if such rate had been a rate of One Shilling in the Pound:
- ii. If any doubt or difficulty arises in connection with ascertaining the amount of or allotting any such subsidy, the same shall be settled by the Minister for Lands and Works, and his decision shall be final.

Aid to Road Rates.

4 Section Three of "The Aid to Road Rates Act, 1906," is hereby repealed, and such repeal shall have a retrospective effect.

5 Notwithstanding the repeal of the Act 3 *Edwardi* VII. No. 22, and their non-compliance with the provisions of Section Six thereof, it shall be lawful for the Treasurer of the State to pay out of the Consolidated Revenue to the trustees of the road districts mentioned in the Schedule the subsidies set opposite their respective names, to which the said trustees respectively would have been entitled if the last-mentioned Act had not been repealed and the said section had been complied with.
