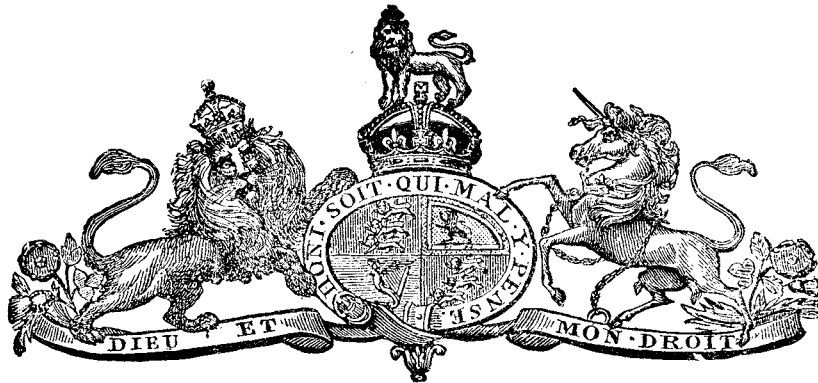

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of 6 Geo. V. No. 13, ss. 19 and 20 (inserted by 17 Geo. V. No. 48, s. 2).

AN ACT to amend the Bursaries Act, 1915. ^{A.D.} 1930.
 [23 December, 1930.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Bursaries Act, 1930." Short title.
- 2 The Bursaries Act, 1915, is hereby amended—
 - I. By deleting the word "Twelve" in the seventh line of Section Nineteen and substituting therefor the word "Ten": and Amendment of 6 Geo V. No. 13, ss. 19 and 20 (inserted by 17 Geo. V. No. 48, s. 2).
 - II. By deleting the word "Thirty" in the sixth line of Section Twenty and substituting therefor the word "Twenty".
