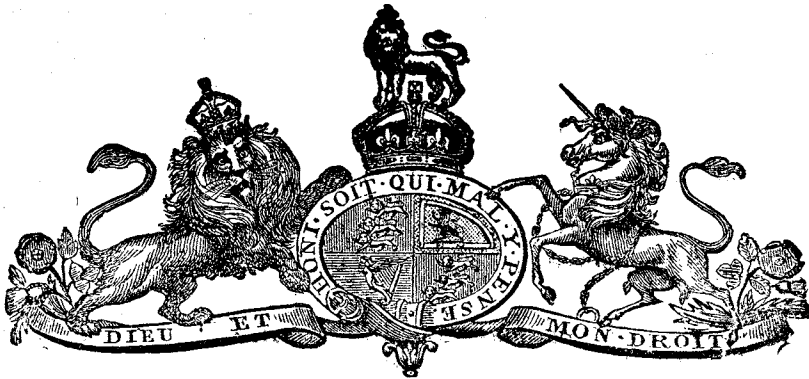

AN ACT to repeal the *Tourist Bureau Act 1917*, and to make further provision for the Administration of the Tasmanian Government Tourist Bureau. [27 November, 1934.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Tourist Bureau Act 1934*.

Short title.

Tourist Bureau.

2 The *Tourist Bureau Act* 1917 is hereby repealed.

Repeal of 8 Geo.

Interpretation.

3 In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—

“The Director” means the Director of the Tourist Bureau :

“The Tourist Bureau” means the Tasmanian Government Tourist Bureau.

Appointment,
&c., of Director
and other officers.

4—(1) The Governor may appoint a Director of the Tourist Bureau and such other officers as he thinks fit for the purposes of this Act.

(2) The Director and any other officers so appointed shall receive such remuneration as the Governor determines.

(3) The officers of the Tourist Bureau shall not be subject to the *Public Service Act* 1923 or the *Railway Management Act* 1891, but any officer of the Public Service or of the Railway Service who is appointed under this Act shall retain all his existing and accruing rights.

(4) Subject to this section, officers appointed under this Act shall be subject to such conditions as may be prescribed.

Change of name
of Tourist

5 The Tasmanian Government Tourist and Information Bureau, as at present carried on, shall be known as the Tasmanian Government Tourist Bureau.

Administration of
Tourist Bureau.

6 Subject to the supervision of the Minister, the administration, management, and control of the Tourist Bureau shall be vested in the Director.

Powers of
Director.

7 The Director may—

i. Carry on the Tourist Bureau as a general tourist business on behalf of the State, with power to enter into such contracts, establish such branch or other offices and agencies in this State or elsewhere (including power to rent premises), appoint such agents, and to provide and maintain such facilities and conveniences for tourists, as the Director thinks desirable : and

ii. Generally, do and carry out any matter or thing which in his opinion may promote, further, or facilitate tourist traffic to and in this State or may be of service to tourists.

Provision of
funds.

8 The expenditure incurred in the administration of the Tourist Bureau as provided by this Act shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

Tourist Bureau.

9 No person other than the Director, or some person authorised by the Minister in writing, shall trade or carry on business under, or in any way use in connection with any trade or business, or on any business premises, any name or names containing—

- i. The words "Government Tourist Bureau," "Tasmanian Government Tourist Bureau," "Tasmanian Tourist Bureau," or "State Tourist Bureau"; or
- ii. Any words which are an imitation of the name of the Tourist Bureau carried on by the Director; or
- iii. Any words which are likely to mislead or deceive the public into the belief that such trade or business is identical or connected with the Tourist Bureau as carried on by the Director.

Penalty : One hundred pounds.

10 The Director, once in every year, shall make a report to the Minister on the administration of the Tourist Bureau during the preceding year.

Annual report of Director.

11 The Minister shall cause the yearly report of the Director to be laid before both Houses of Parliament within thirty days after the receipt thereof if Parliament is then sitting, and, if not, within thirty days after the next meeting of Parliament.

Report to be presented to Parliament.

12 The Governor may make regulations for the purposes of this Act and any such regulations may provide for the appointment by the Governor of an advisory committee to advise the Minister upon any matters affecting the administration of this Act.

Regulations.

13 This Act shall remain in operation until the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six.
