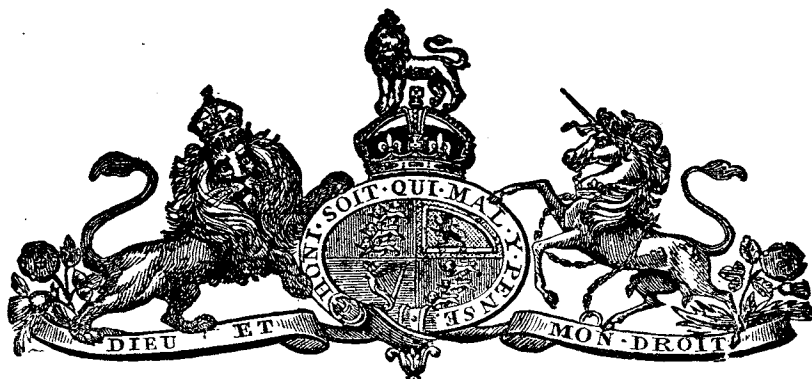

AN ACT to amend the *Tourist Bureau Act*
1934. [17 December, 1935.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Tourist Bureau Act 1935*.

Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (4) of section four thereof the following new subsection (5):—

“(5) The Director, with the approval of the Minister, may appoint temporarily as prescribed such officers as may be required in a temporary capacity; but no such appointment shall be for a term exceeding twelve months (inclusive of any renewal thereof).”

Amendment of
section 13.

3 Section thirteen of the Principal Act is hereby amended as from its commencement—

- I. By inserting “(1)” (at the commencement) :
- II. By deleting “thirty-six” (in the second line) and substituting “thirty-seven” : and
- III. By adding the following new subsections (2) and (3) :—
 - “(2) No contract lawfully entered into by the Director for the purposes of this Act shall be affected or invalidated by such expiry as aforesaid :
 - “(3) Where any such contract as aforesaid remains in force at the time of such expiry the same shall during its continuance be binding upon any person in whom the administration, management, and control of the Tourist Bureau becomes vested as if such person had been a party thereto in place of the Director.”
