

AN ACT to provide for the Establishment of 1911. Public Abattoirs for the Municipality Emu Bay, and for other purposes. [10] January, 1912.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to provide public abattoirs for the PREAMBLE. Municipality of Emu Bay, and to purchase land at Cooee Creek, Emu Bay, for that purpose:

Burnie Abattoirs.

And whereas the Council of the said Municipality is desirous of obtaining legislative authority to appropriate the sum of One thousand four hundred Pounds to its credit under "The Burnie Sewerage Act, 1907," on the Burnie Sewerage Construction Account, for that purpose:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and incorporation with 7 Ed. VII. No. 21.

1 This Act may be cited as "The Burnie Abattoirs Act, 1911," and shall be deemed incorporated with and be read as one with "The Burnie Sewerage Act, 1907," hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act.

Interpretation.

- 2 In this Act and all proceedings under the authority of this Act-
 - "The Corporation" means the Warden, councillors, and electors of the Municipality of Emu Bay:
 - "The Council" means the Municipal Council of the said Municipality:
 - "Municipality" means the Municipality of Emu Bay.

Power to appropriate and apply £1400 out of loan under Principal Act for purposes of public abattoirs.

3 It shall be lawful for the Council on behalf of the Corporation to appropriate and apply out of the moneys borrowed under the provisions of the Principal Act, and to the credit of the Burnie Sewerage Construction Account, the sum of One thousand four hundred Pounds for the purpose of providing and erecting public abattoirs for the said Municipality at Cooee Creek, Emu Bay, in Tasmania, and of purchasing a site in connection therewith, and for all other purposes incidental thereto: Provided that it shall not be necessary to lay before either House of Parliament plans and specifications of any such public abattoirs or works, nor the report of the Engineer-in-Chief thereon; but before any part of the said sum of One thousand four hundred Pounds shall be appropriated or applied as aforesaid, plans and specifications of the proposed abattoirs or works, together with such reports upon the probable cost of the same, the suitability of the site proposed therefor, the sufficiency of the plans and specifications, and upon such other matters as may be deemed desirable, shall be submitted to and be subject to approval by the Governor.

Power to Council to levy rate.

4 It shall be lawful for the Council Once in every year to make and levy a special rate of not exceeding One Halfpenny in the pound upon the annual value of all properties within the said Municipality, as shown by the assessment roll in force for the time being, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Act, and providing for the payment of interest upon any moneys appropriated for the purposes of this Act. Any such rate shall be made

upon and be payable by the persons who would be liable to be rated if A.D. 1911. such rate were a general rate under "The Local Government Act, 1906," and shall be made and recoverable in the same manner as any such general rate.

5 The loan authorised by the Principal Act shall, until repayment, Loan to be and all interest and other money from time to time due in respect charge, thereof shall, until payment thereof to the State Treasurer, be and remain a charge upon the revenues of the Council,
