

AN ACT to amend "The Beer Duty Act, A.D. 1891. [17 November, 1891.] 1880."

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Beer Duty Act, Short title.
- 2 So much of Section Two of "The Beer Duty Act, 1880," as Definition of relates to the definition of the word "Beer" is hereby repealed, and in "Beer." lieu thereof the following definition of the word "Beer" shall hereafter 43 Vict. No. 10. be used in the construction of the said Act and any Regulations made thereunder; that is to say:-

- "Beer" means and includes ale, porter, and all other malt liquors; also any other beverage made in imitation of beer or malt liquor, and brewed or made in whole or in part from any other substance than malt, and containing Two per centum or more by weight of alcohol or other intoxicating spirit or ingredient.
- 3 This Act and "The Beer Duty Act, 1880," save as amended by Acts to be read together. this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.
