AN ACT to amend the Tobacco Business Franchise Licences Act 1980

[Royal Assent 25 June 1993]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Tobacco Business Franchise Licences Amendment Act 1993.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Tobacco Business Franchise Licences Act 1980* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 20 amended (Licence fees)

- 4—Section 20 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—
 - (a) by omitting from subsection (1) (a) "50 per cent" and substituting "100 per cent";
 - (b) by omitting from subsection (1) (b) "50 per cent" and substituting "100 per cent";
 - (c) by omitting from subsection (1) (c) "50 per cent" and substituting "100 per cent";
 - (d) by omitting from subsection (8A) (a) "50 per cent" and substituting "100 per cent";
 - (e) by omitting from subsection (8A) (b) "50 per cent" and substituting "100 per cent";
 - (f) by omitting from subsection (8A) (c) "50 per cent" and substituting "100 per cent".

Application of Act

- 5—The amendments made to the Principal Act by this Act apply to fees payable in respect of—
 - (a) a licence or renewal of a licence issued in respect of a month which commenced on or after 1 August 1993, whether the application for that licence or renewal was made before or after the commencement of that month; and

(b) a licence in force immediately before 1 September 1993 where the holder does not renew that licence for any month commencing on or after that date, whether the holder had given notice of the intention not to renew the licence before or after that date.
