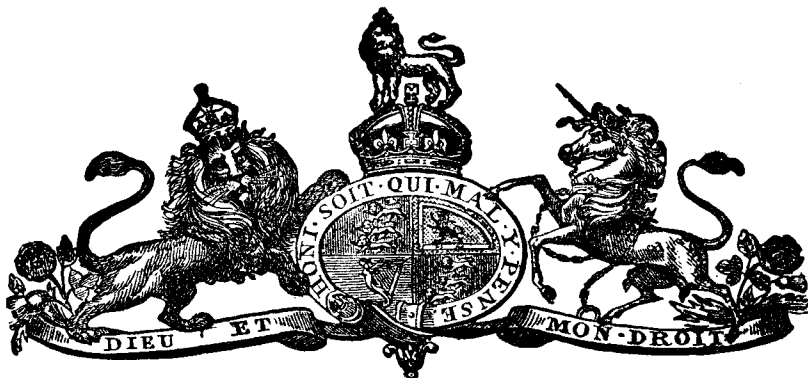

AN ACT to amend the Bank Holidays Act, 1919. [14 November, 1927.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as “The Bank Holidays Act, 1927.” Short title.
- 2 The Bank Holidays Act, 1919, is hereby amended— Amendment of  
10 Geo. V. No. 8
  - i. By expunging therefrom Paragraph iv. of Subsection (1) of Section Four thereof, and substituting the following new Paragraph iv. therefor:—  
“iv. The twenty-sixth day of January if such day falls on a Monday; and in every other case, the Monday next after such twenty-sixth day.”
  - ii. By inserting after Paragraph v. of the same subsection the following new Paragraph vi. :—  
“vi. The twenty-fifth day of April.”
