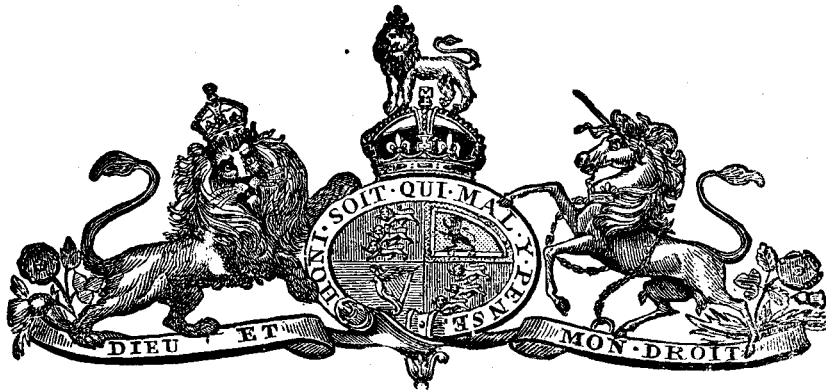

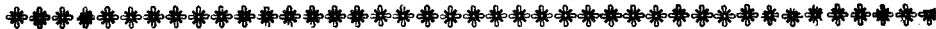

AN ACT to further amend "The Bank
Holidays Act, 1903." [30 October, 1917.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Bank Holidays Amendment Act, 1917," and shall be construed as one with "The Bank Holidays Act, 1903," in this Act referred to as the Principal Act, and every Act amending the Principal Act. Short title.
