

- 1. Short title.
- 2. Bellevue Parade to be at least Forty feet wide.

AN ACT respecting Bellevue Parade, in the 1910. Municipality of New Town.

[13 January, 1911.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Bellevue Parade Act, 1910."

Short title.

2 In its application to Bellevue Parade, in the Municipality of Bellevue Parade New Town, Section One hundred and sixty-eight of "The Police Act, to be at least Forty feet wide. 5 Edw. VII. substituted for the word "Fifty" in line Two. This section shall have No. 30, a retrospective effect.
