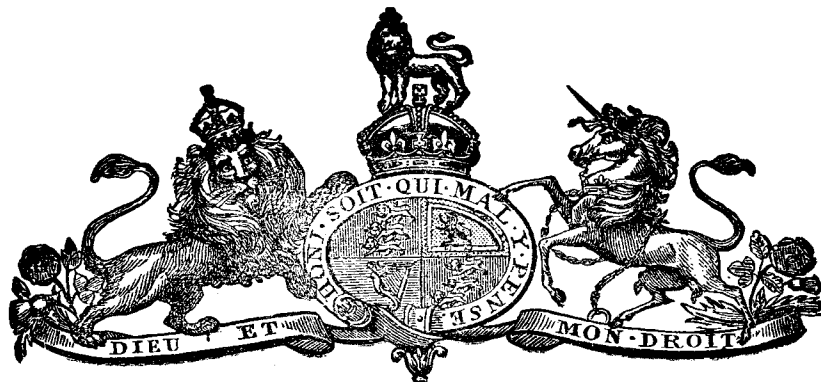

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.
2. Bellevue Parade to be at least Forty feet wide.

AN ACT respecting *Bellevue* Parade, in the ^{A.D.}1910.
Municipality of *New Town*.
[13 *January*, 1911.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The *Bellevue* Parade Act, 1910.” Short title.

2 In its application to *Bellevue* Parade, in the Municipality of *New Town*, Section One hundred and sixty-eight of “The Police Act, 1905.” shall be read and construed as if the word “Forty” were substituted for the word “Fifty” in line Two. This section shall have a retrospective effect.
