

AN ACT to amend "The Building Societies A.D. 1877. Act, 1876." [27 January, 1877.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Building Societies PREAMBLE, Act, 1876:"

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Building Societies Amendment Short title.
- 2 The Fourth Section of "The Building Societies Act, 1876," is Repeal. hereby repealed.
- 3 The Governor may from time to time appoint such person as he Registrar of shall see fit to be the Registrar of Building Societies for the purposes of Building So-"The Building Societies Act, 1876," and any such appointment may cieties. from time to time revoke. And until any such appointment is made, the Clerk of the Peace at *Hobart Town* for the time being shall be the Registrar of Building Societies.
- 4 For every such Certificate of Rules of any such Society, a fee of Fees to be paid Two Guineas shall be paid to the said Registrar; and for every Certificates and cate of alteration, addition to, or rescission of the Rules of any Society, awards. a fee of Two Guineas; and for every Award, a fee of Three Guineas; and for every opinion on matters referred to him under the said Act, a fee of One Guinea.

Building Societies Act Amendment.

5 All rights of action and other rights, and all estates and interests in real and personal estate whatsoever, now belonging to or held in trust for any Society the rules of which have been certified, confirmed, and filed under the "Act for the Regulation of Benefit Building Societies," shall, on the incorporation of the Society under "The Building Societies Act, 1876," vest in the Society without any conveyance or assignment whatsoever.

Acts to be read together.

6 This Act and "The Building Societies Act, 1876," shall, save so far as the same is altered by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act.
