AN ACT to make provision for the Marine A.D. 1874.
Survey of *Banks' Straits*.
[18 September, 1874.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for a contribution to the **PREAMBLE.**
cost of a Marine Survey of *Banks' Straits* :

And whereas it has been agreed between the Government of the Colony of *Victoria* and the Government of *Tasmania* that the proportion of the cost of such Survey to be borne by the Government of *Tasmania* shall be a sum not exceeding Three thousand Pounds :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause a Marine **Marine Survey**
Survey of *Banks' Straits* to be made in conjunction with the **of Banks' Straits.**
Government of the Colony of *Victoria*, and by and under the supervision of the Admiralty Surveyors.

2 A proportion of the cost of such Survey, not exceeding Three **Defrayment of**
thousand Pounds, shall be borne by this Colony, and shall be defrayed **cost.**
out of the moneys to be hereafter provided by Parliament.

3 This Act may be cited as "The *Banks' Straits* Survey Act." **Short title.**
