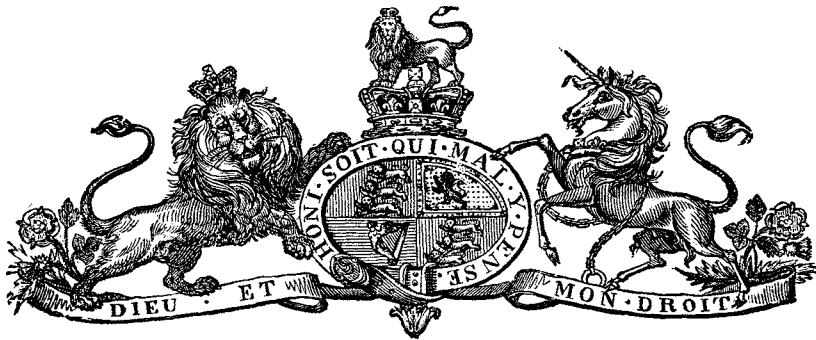

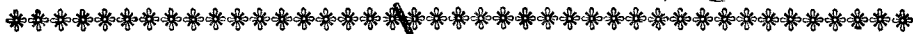

AN ACT to amend the Act of this Island, intituled *An Act to repeal an Act, intituled An Act for taking an Annual Account of the Population of the Island of Van Diemen's Land, and to make provision for the taking an Account of the Population of the said Island triennially.*

[17th January, 1857.]

WHEREAS it is necessary to amend so much of the Act of this Island, intituled *An Act to amend an Act, intituled An Act to amend an Act for taking an Annual Account of the Population of the Island of Van Diemen's Land, and to make provision for the taking an Account of the Population of the said Island triennially*, as relates to the subdivision of the Colony into Parishes for the purposes of the said Act: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.
7 Vict., No. 5.

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor, for the purpose of enabling an accurate account of the Population of this Colony to be taken from time to time, as to him shall seem expedient, to cause Letters Patent to be issued under the Public Seal of this Colony, dividing this Colony

Governor from time to time to divide the Colony into Parishes for Census purposes.

into Parishes; and the Parishes so for the time being established shall be deemed and taken to be Parishes within the intent and meaning and for the purposes of the said recited Act, and of the Act of this Island of the 9th *Victoria*, No. 3.

3 This Act, and the said firstly recited Act, and the said Act of the 9th *Victoria*, No. 3, except in so far as the said firstly recited Act is repealed or altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
