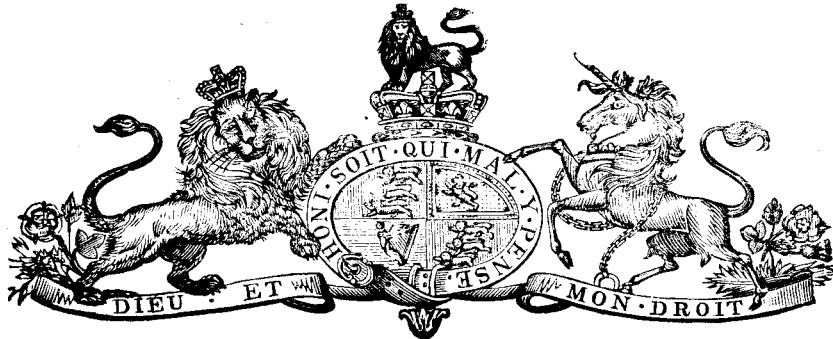

AN ACT to further amend "The Cemeteries Act, 1865." A.D. 1903.
[6 January, 1904.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The Cemeteries Act, 1865." PREAMBLE.
29 Vict. No. 7.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Cemeteries Act, 1903." Short title.

2 The Cemeteries or burial grounds situate in the Town of *Glenorchy* and known respectively as the Church of *England* burial ground, the Presbyterian burial ground, and the Methodist burial ground, are hereby closed, and it shall not be lawful after the passing of this Act, to bury or permit or suffer to be buried any further corpses or coffins in such burial grounds. Cemeteries or burial grounds in Town or *Glenorchy* to be closed.

3 The provisions of Section One hundred and fourteen of "The Public Health Act, 1903," shall not apply to any cemetery or burial ground closed under the provisions of this Act.

4 This Act and "The Cemeteries Act, 1865," and every Act amending the same, save as altered or amended by this Act, shall be read and construed as one and the same Act.
