

#### AN ACT to further amend The Cemeteries Act, A.D. 1880. 1865. [1 November, 1880.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Whenever any Cemetery, established under the provisions of The Power to close Cemeteries Act, 1865, shall be opened and ready for use, the Governor Burial Grounds in Council, upon being satisfied that, for the protection of the public health, all existing Burial Grounds and places of interment within health, all existing Burial Grounds and places of interment within a distance of One mile from any such Cemetery should be closed, that such Cemetery provides sufficient means of interment and that the Rules of such Cemetery sufficiently provide for permitting the burial of poor and indigent persons therein free of charge, may by Proclamation to be published in the Gazette, and in One newspaper published in Hobert Town if such Cemetery is situate within One published in Hobart Town if such Cemetery is situate within One of the Southern Electoral Districts, and in One newspaper published in Launceston if such Cemetery is situate within One of the Northern Electoral Districts, to direct that on and after a day to be named in such Proclamation, not being less than Three months from the date of such Proclamation, all existing Burial Grounds and places of interment within a distance of One mile from such Cemetery shall be closed; and on and after such day it shall not be lawful to bury, or permit or suffer to be buried, any further corpses or coffins in any such Burial Ground or place of interment; and whosoever, on or after such day, buries or causes to be buried, or permits or suffers to be buried, any

corpse or coffin contrary to this enactment, shall for every such offence forfeit and pay a penalty of not less than Five Pounds nor more than Fifty Pounds; and the amount of all penalties so recovered shall be paid to the Trustees of the Cemetery so established, and shall be by them applied in the same manner as other penalties payable to such Trustees are applicable.

The provisions of this Act shall not apply to the City of Hobart

Town and the Town of Launceston.

# Acts to be read together.

2 This Act and the said Act, and every Act amending the same shall, save as altered or amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act.

#### Short title.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Cemeteries Amendment Act, 1880."
